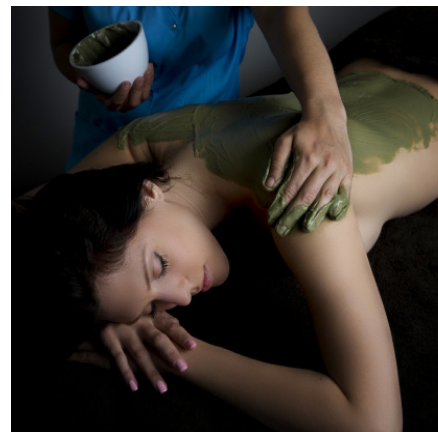

FULLY EQUIPPED ROOMS



GRAND HÔTEL DES BAINS

Located in the centre of town, the Grand Hotel des Bains offers two meeting rooms and a lounge, with a capacity of eight to 100 persons. Facilities include Wi-Fi, television, digital presentation and video equipment. The hotel staff can also provide other facilities, such as a conference telephone with a dedicated videoconferencing line.

This entirely renovated hotel offers 29 rooms with every modern comfort. The restaurant's savoury cuisine perfectly combines the typical flavours of the Jura mountains with the originality of gourmet cooking.

CREDIT AGRICOLE HOUSE

Completely refurbished in 2015, this historic landmark and part of the history of Salins, is a symbol of the cooperative model and the ideal place to organize your working meetings.

With a capacity of 35 to 70 persons, the venue offers all the comfort and peace needed for a studious working atmosphere, plus it has a breath-taking view of Mount Poupet.

CHANTEPIERRE MILL

Inside the mill, a hall of 90 square metres offers a capacity of up to 25 persons and is at your disposal for the organization of your seminars.

To allow you to work in total serenity, the mill offers all the facilities and equipment you will need.

MEETING ROOMS

HÔTEL DES DEUX FORTS

The Deux Fort Hotel has 23 rooms boasting every modern comfort.

The hotel's restaurant hall can accommodate up to 65 guests. It offers a sophisticated menu with regional produce from Franche-Comté.

CHARLES SANDER RESIDENCE

At the heart of Salins, the Charles Sander Residence offers an atypical, yet very hospitable vaulted hall in which to host your seminars. It opens onto a beautiful patio, allowing moments of relaxation and escape.

FORT SAINT-ANDRÉ

Overlooking the Salins valley, the village of Vauban is nestled inside a fort from the 17th Century. Its exceptional setting makes it one of the most prestigious sites in the Jura mountains. It offers all the infrastructure necessary for the success of your seminars. The fort's four meeting rooms can accommodate 15 to 80 persons.

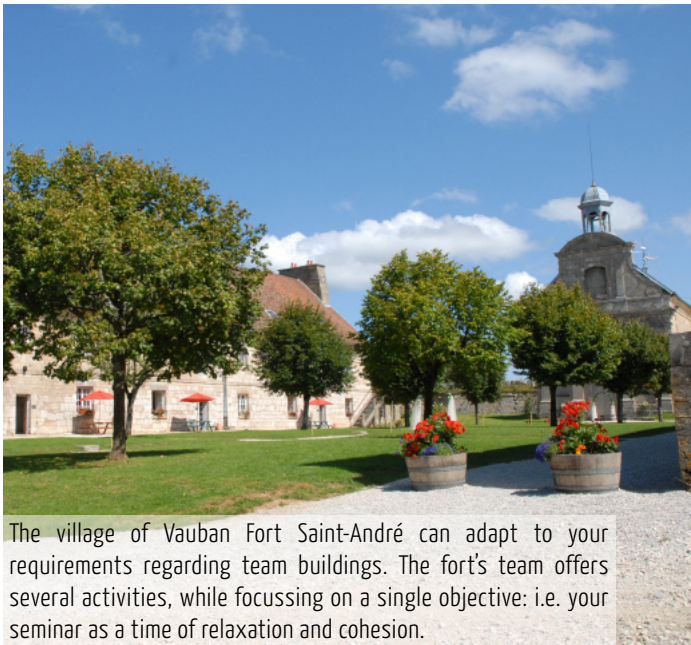

CASINO LE SENSSO

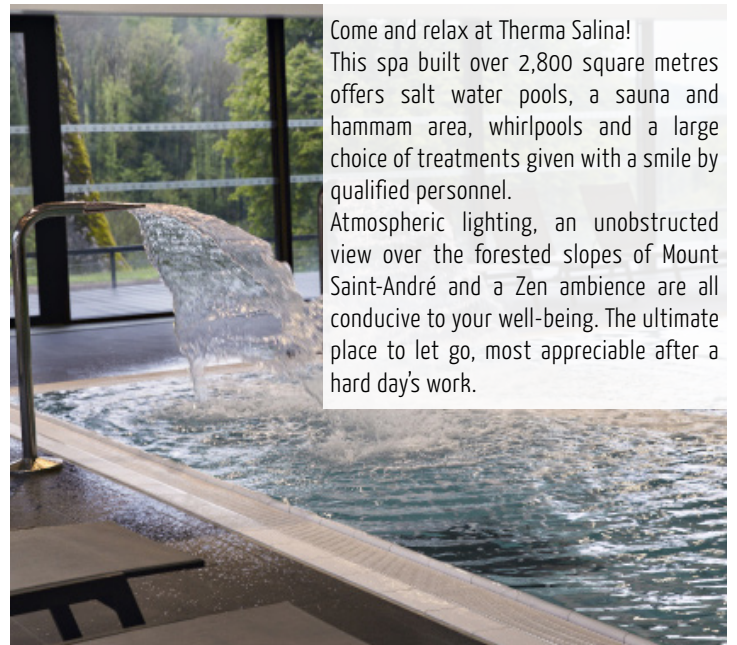
Should you wish to combine seminars and gastronomy for a group of more than 100 persons, the casino is the right place!

With a capacity of 150 persons, the casino hall provides all the equipment necessary and a stage to help make the most of your meetings.

Its modern structure, ideally located in the town centre and its open aspects to the Belin fort make it a unique platform for meeting and networking, combining elegance and comfort.



The village of Vauban Fort Saint-André can adapt to your requirements regarding team buildings. The fort's team offers several activities, while focussing on a single objective: i.e. your seminar as a time of relaxation and cohesion.



Come and relax at Therma Salina! This spa built over 2,800 square metres offers salt water pools, a sauna and hammam area, whirlpools and a large choice of treatments given with a smile by qualified personnel. 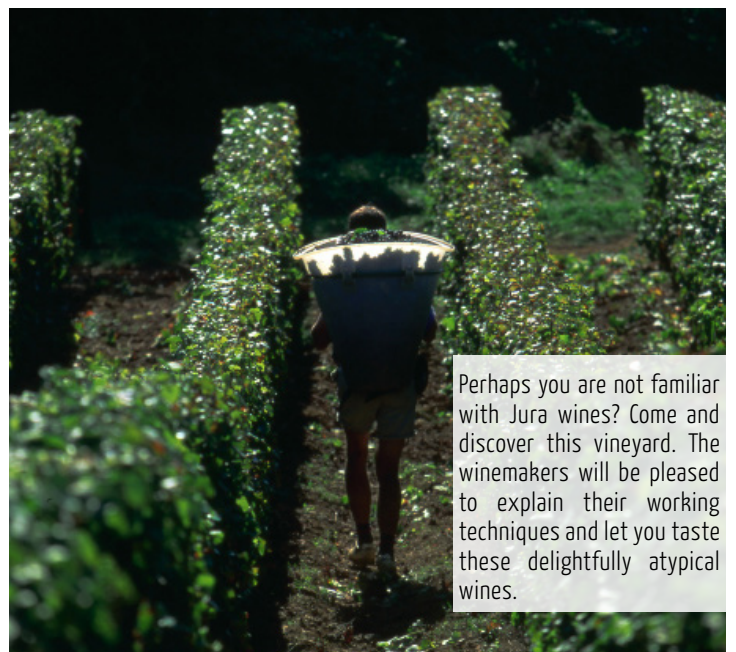
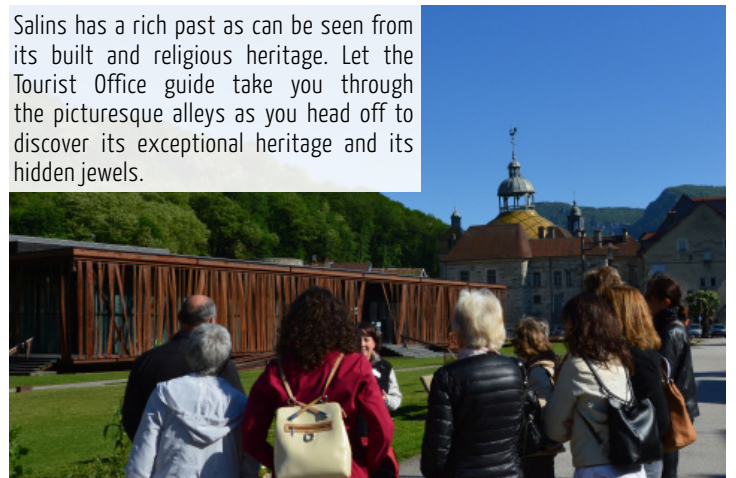
WHAT ELSE AFTER WORK?

Salins-les-Bains offers a multitude of highly varied activities, all of which are hard to resist. Whether just for a few hours or half a day, they will leave a lasting impression.



A witness of 1200 years of continuous salt production, the Grande Saline has been listed as a UNESCO world heritage site since 2009. Its underground gallery with a length of 165m, its working 19th Century pumping system and last saltpan in France make this a real jewel of Franche-Comté heritage.

Salins has a rich past as can be seen from its built and religious heritage. Let the Tourist Office guide take you through the picturesque alleys as you head off to discover its exceptional heritage and its hidden jewels.



Perhaps you are not familiar with Jura wines? Come and discover this vineyard. The winemakers will be pleased to explain their working techniques and let you taste these delightfully atypical wines.



Extend the experience as you please!

It takes less than 20 minutes by car to discover Arbois and Poligny, two towns of great character where you can sample Jura wines and Comté cheese, learn about or review the life of Louis Pasteur and be amazed by the numerous natural sites.

Within a 15km radius of Salins-les-Bains, you can join the site of the royal saltworks, Saline Royale d'Arc-et-Senans. Take the opportunity to continue discovering the history of salt in the area. The village of Nans-sous-Sainte-Anne is the same distance away and shelters a blacksmith's - a manufacturing site for agricultural scythes, as well as it being the source of the river Lison.
